- Sensing, Connectivity, and Human Factors in Connected and Automated Driving
- Big Data and Artificial Intelligence Theory Methods and Applications

Special Focus Areas

We also encourage submissions that explore interdisciplinary applications of IoT, AI, and knowledge systems in areas such as: smart manufacturing, robotics, agriculture, environmental sensing, transportation, education technologies, and ethical/social impacts of pervasive computing.

Submission Types

We solicit the following submission categories:

- **Full research papers** (describing original and unpublished work)
- **Short papers and position papers** (significant work-in-progress or visionary ideas)

All submissions must be **original and unpublished**, and not under simultaneous review elsewhere.

Publication and Indexing

All submissions will be subject to peer-review process and accepted and presented papers will be submitted for inclusion into **IEEE Xplore®** subject to meeting IEEE Xplore's scope and quality requirements. IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the conference, including IEEE Xplore® Digital Library, if the paper is not presented by the author at the conference. Selected high-quality papers may be invited for **extended journal publication**.
